Dear Parishioners:

The Church has always struggled to keep up with changes and modifications within society and in most instances throughout history it has always lagged behind somewhat. Part of that is because as a universal institution things change in different parts of the world at one time and perhaps a generation or so later in another part of the world. Issues that seem to be on the front burner in America may be not that important in Europe and not an issue at all in the emerging church in Africa and Asia. Much of this has to do with deeply rooted cultural issues that change at a pace often slower than the Church.

One of the ways the Church in New York and other places is trying to keep its parishioners informed is an email notification system called Flocknotes. Used on a parish level it enables us to notify you of upcoming events, changes in schedules, cancellations, and general information that effects the parish community.

We have been using this system for several years and have had very good reports from people who like being kept up to date. We use the email address that you give us when registering but if your email changes you have to let us know so we can change our records.



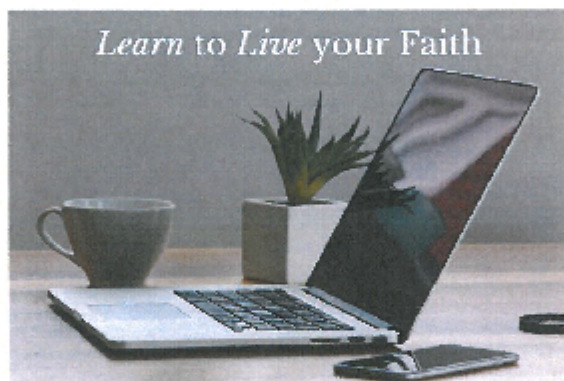
