

Your Child's Baptism

We are delighted to take this opportunity to share with you some important information you will need for your child's baptism. On the day of the baptism, please remember the following:

- Please dress your child at home.
- Arrive at Church by 1:00 p.m. (the ceremony starts promptly at 1:15 p.m.)
- Parents, godparents and child go to Room 109 in the Parish Center; guests go directly to the Church.
- For the ceremony, please remove bonnets, bows, or ribbons from your child's head.
- Please open the top button on your child's shirt / dress for the first anointing.
- If there is an emergency proxy for a godparent, please notify the priest or deacon upon arrival. The proxy must be a Confirmed Roman Catholic, the same gender as the godparent who is absent.

Baptism Preparation Information

Godparents

Godparent (sponsor) is a sacramental ministry. The sponsor takes part in the ritual as a Catholic and provides example from her/his life through living and acting as a full member of the Catholic Church. Because of the seriousness of this ministry, the Church has the following requirements:

1. The sponsor must be a full member of the Catholic Church through Baptism and Confirmation and Eucharist and at least 16 years old (the responsibilities of this ministry are undertaken by an adult).
2. The sponsor must be a Catholic living an active life in the Church who provides good example. Someone married outside the Church is not able to receive Communion and is not able to be a sponsor. Also, a Catholic who has left the Church is not able to be a sponsor of a new member into the Church.
3. When there are two sponsors, they are "spiritual parents" and are godfather and godmother.
