Mass Times: We discussed Mass time schedules, questions we've heard about how/if they might be modified – but also how that would affect current Faith Formation schedules. Mass attendance hasn't been affected by the change and there's been no loss in Faith Formation enrollment. Timing for Faith Formation is a key; suggested that parishioners discuss this directly with Father Frank and Father Kevin if they have questions or concerns.

Generations of Faith: At the time of the meeting, \$788,760 had been pledged from 160 families.

Updates on Gen of Faith priority projects: The repair to the front steps will be done first, with a loan (will be paid as the Generations of Faith pledges come in, based on paid pledges); with the Parish Hall renovation to follow at a later date, but likely will be done over two-three years and including new meeting rooms and a new sound system/projector.

Other items:

- Ministry Fair is Oct. 22-23 (Geri Anne needs help with setup and manning tables)
- Father Frank shared a Stole of Remembrance project idea for next year (the stole is made of fabric in remembrance of family and friends); visits from Creative Ministries and the Glen Mohr chorale; morning/aft of prayer for all ministers.
