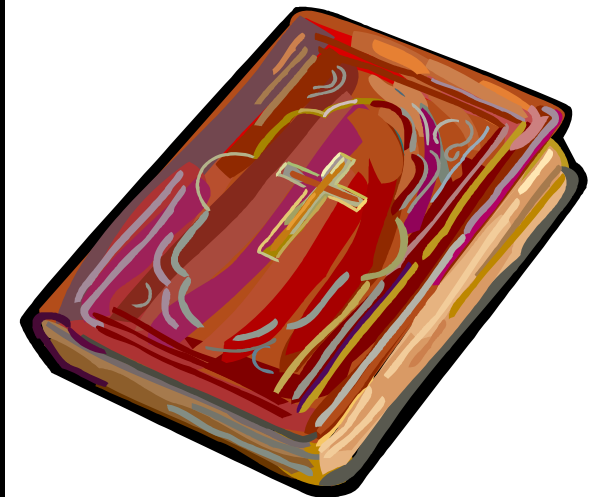

R.C.I.A. stands for  
Rite of Christian Initiation  
for Adults

Modeled after the  
Catechumenate of the early  
Apostolic Church, R.C.I.A.  
consists of periods of  
Spiritual growth and  
Formation in the  
Catholic faith

At St. Saviour Parish the  
R.C.I.A. meets weekly in the  
Parish Hall from mid-Sept to  
Pentecost (May/June)

Those attending our weekly  
gathering come to a deeper  
appreciation and understanding  
of the Catholic beliefs and  
practices

Meetings for the  
R.C.I.A. Program take place on  
Sunday mornings  
in the Parish Hall  
Conference Room

After a period of Inquiry,  
those adults who wish to be  
accepted into the Catholic Faith  
celebrate a public  
Rite of Acceptance in Church,  
and then continue  
in their faith formation until it is  
time to receive the sacraments of  
Baptism & Eucharist at the Easter  
Vigil and Confirmation  
at Pentecost

After the Rite of Acceptance  
Catechumens and Candidates  
attend Mass together – as well as  
the weekly gathering- to learn  
more about the faith through the  
Liturgy of the Word,  
teachings, sharing and  
praying together.
